WATER IN EAST GWILLIMBURY

WATER/WASTEWATER RATES

Did you know that 52% of your water bill goes to York Region and 48% pays for Town operations and infrastructure?

YORK REGION RESPONSIBILITY

York Region provides the Town with clean, treated drinking water.

The Region also processes and treats wastewater.

! York Region supplies EG with water, and takes it away afterwards for treatment.

EAST GWILLIMBURY RESPONSIBILITY

The Town's role is to maintain the water system (pipes) to ensure that every time you turn on your tap there is safe drinking water.

The Town is also responsible for ensuring that wastewater is collected and transferred to the Regional system for effective treatment.

! Once water is in EG the Town ensures it travels to and from your home safely.

MOSQUITO CONTROL PROGRAM

The Town's mosquito control program is scheduled to begin in early April, weather permitting. The program consists of application of a biological larvicide (VectoBac 200G [PCP#18158, granular formulation]), by helicopter, to standing water mosquito breeding habitats within the Town.

Property owners within the treatment areas were mailed objection forms. If you object to having Vectobac applied to your property, please submit a completed objection form by Friday, April 5, 2019. No response is required if you support the mosquito control program.
