## WATER IN EAST GWILLIMBURY

The 2019 budget was approved by Council on March 19, 2019. There is no increase to the residential water and wastewater usage rates. The fixed/delivery charges for both water and wastewater have been increased by \$5 to \$70, which is billed quarterly per service.

### WHY ARE MY RATES INCREASING?

- York Region is the sole supplier of water and wastewater treatment for the Town. A 9% increase in their rates, translates to approximately \$32 or 80% of the rate increase reflected in the Town rates.
  - Town costs are made up of salaries, benefits, materials, supplies, and contracted services in order to provide the water and wastewater program. Inflationary pressures in these areas represent approximately \$8 or 20% of the rate increase
