

CWC/COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

From August 13, 2019

Winter Maintenance Update - The Town responded to 67 winter events this past season. The Town continues to closely monitor changing road conditions and through progressive winter operation techniques has been able to reduce the amount of salt and sand used compared to previous years. Preparations for the upcoming winter season are already underway.

Fill Site Update - There is an application to operate a Commercial Fill Site at the former Overholt Pit at 18725 McCowan Rd. The applicant is proposing to have a maximum of 200 trucks per day travelling from Davis Dr. and heading north on McCowan Rd. to the site. A Public Information Centre (PIC) was held in June, and the applicant is working to incorporate the issues noted at the PIC in an updated Fill Management Plan. Zoning By-law Update - Staff proposed changes to the Zoning By-law. If the changes are approved it would ensure the protection of private property rights for residents by retaining the zoning approved in May 2018 and carried forward from 1997. It would also zone 1,000 acres of publicly owned land as Environmental Protection which upholds the Town's commitment to protecting the environment. In an effort to promote clarity and transparency, the by-law would also now include mapping schedules of Provincial, Regional, and LSRCA land use regulations, which would ensure that residents are informed of all controls that may exist on their property. These changes have been referred to the September 17, 2019 Council meeting for approval. A community open house will be held on September 11 to discuss the Zoning By-law. PROPERTY TAXES

Final 2019 residential tax bills have been mailed and payments are due on August 30 and October 31. Payments can be made at the Civic Centre, at your bank, online/phone banking or through a pre-authorized payment plan.

If your tax account is not current, a pre-set monthly payment can be arranged to help you catch up on tax arrears. Unpaid taxes will be charged 1.25% interest per month effective the first day of default. Failure to receive a tax bill does not exempt the bill from being due or from incurring interest.
