

## CWC/COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

### March 3, 2020 CWC/Council Highlights

**Telecommunications Tower Update** – Committee of the Whole Council recommended that the residential telecommunications tower may remain in the current location until ground level fibre servicing or acceptable internet services are available for the neighbourhood. This is for up to a maximum of 30 months, at which time the owner and the Town will investigate relocation. The recommendation is subject to specific conditions, including safety and appropriate landscaping. These resolutions attempt to balance Council's commitment to enhancing access to broadband with the needs of the neighbourhood residents. Council will review these recommendations for final approval at 7 p.m. on March 24, 2020.

**Tapestry of Taste Update** – Town staff have evaluated feedback from the community and are recommending changes to this year's event including, holding the event on Friday night and Saturday only and at the Civic Centre. Event features will include an expanded food market, Farm to Fork zone, art show and sale, and a continued focus on multicultural entertainment and family friendly activities. The event will be held on August 7 and 8, 2020.

**Drinking Water System** –The Town maintains five drinking water systems for residents. In order to comply with the Safe Drinking Water Act and its regulations, staff conducted over 5,350 water samples in 2019 and the drinking water systems received 100% compliance during the annual Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks inspections. **New Environmental Programs** –The Town is launching a new Battery Recycling Program and a Used Textile Diversion Program. Once launched residents will be able to drop off used batteries at a variety of Town facilities including the Civic Centre, Sports Complex, Ross Family Complex and Holland Landing Community Centre. The textile drop off program will initially be located at the Sports Complex. Private textile drop off programs are available throughout the Town at some retail and plaza locations. Further communications will be shared as the programs officially launch.
