The East Gwillimbury Public Library is now open for curbside pickup!

Curbside pickup provides the Library with the opportunity to lend material to the public in a safe way during the COVID-19 pandemic. Customers will be able to place holds on library material and staff will contact you when your items are ready. Items will be picked up during our Curbside Pickup hours, either by car, biking or walking.

All library materials are available for pick up including the popular technology items such as hotspots, Chromebooks, cameras, and computer equipment, which are available for one week. All other holds will be available for a two-week period. Curbside pickup hours are:

- Tuesdays - 10:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.
- Thursdays - 4:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.
- Saturdays - 10:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

Borrowed items can be returned during the hours listed above.

The Library has made it easy to place a hold online through their catalogue at www.egpl.ca, by email at info@egpl.ca or by calling the Library directly or make your request. EG Library staff are extremely passionate about what they do and are available to provide assistance if required.
