

## COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

From June 23, 2020

**Cannabis Update** - Council has taken further steps to address unregulated cannabis production facilities in rural municipalities by passing a resolution requesting the Minister of Health and Attorney General establish a committee to coordinate efforts and increase communications between federal and municipal governments as well as the relevant police services. This coordination would help to ensure that these facilities are fully compliant with all levels of legislation and ensure that these sites are operating in a safe manner. **Camp in a Box** - The Town has partnered with the Sharon Temple and EG Library to bring summer camp fun in a box! **Permit and Programs Update** - The Town is working with Public Health to create a Build, Back, Better Recovery Plan for the safe reopening of Town facilities. The plan will also include possible adjustments to Town fall/winter programming to ensure they meet public health guidelines. Further updates will be provided as available.

**Public Meeting** - Staff hosted a virtual public meeting for an Official Plan Amendment (OPA) to establish the Highway 404 Employment Corridor Secondary Plan. The draft OPA sets out the planning vision for the Secondary Plan and provides land use, design, servicing and transportation policies to support the principles and objectives needed to create a complete community. **Former Overholt Pit** - The Rice Group has provided an updated draft Fill Management Plan, that incorporates new regulations from the Ministry of the Environment Conservation and Parks, and feedback from Council and residents. Staff are proposing that the applicant present the updated plan to Council later this fall.
