SECOND CONCESSION

York Region is improving 2nd Concession by widening to four lanes between Green Lane and Doane Road. The project includes curbs, storm sewers, new street lights, a trunk watermain and sanitary sewers.

2nd Concession will be closed to all traffic starting the summer of 2014 from Doane Rd to Queensville Sdrd until the end of 2014 and from Mount Albert Rd to Green Lane until the end of 2015 to construct the bridge at Rogers Reservoir. Access will be maintained throughout construction for residents living and working in the area.

This project is expected to be completed by late 2016. For more information visit eastgwillimbury.ca.

CONSTRUCTION NEWS

York Region has awarded North Rock Group the contract to install water mains and forcemains in East Gwillimbury.

Holland Landing Forcemains: Pipes will be installed from the new Holland Landing Sewage Pumping Station on Bradford St east to Yonge St, north to Parkside Dr then east to 2nd Concession.

Green Lane Forcemain and Watermain: Pipes will be installed from 2nd Concession to just east of the Holland River; the forcemain pipes will connect to the Newmarket Sewage Pumping Station

During construction there will be temporary lane closures. Closures will be posted on variable message signs, on york.ca and via Facebook and Twitter.

Construction is scheduled to begin mid April 2014 with an anticipated completion in spring 2015.
