## Property Taxes Due

The final 2017 property tax bills were mailed on June 26th, 2017. The final payment is due on October 31st.



Payments can be made at the Civic Centre, at your bank, online/phone banking OR: Pre-Authorized Payment Plans:

- 10 month installments (Feb to Nov)
- due date installments

If your tax account is not current a pre-set monthly payment can be arranged to help you catch up on tax arrears. Unpaid taxes will be charged 1.25% per month effective the first day of default. Failure to receive a tax bill does not exempt the bill from being due or from incurring interest. Contact the Town at 905-478-4282 if you have any questions.


