From December 5, 2017

**York Regional Police Presentation** – YRP discussed policing in East Gwillimbury including information about how YRP uses data to guide business decisions, how residents can connect with YRP, and how to report crime in the community. ### New Parks

- Samuel Lount Park is being reconstructed to include new play areas and sitting areas, this park is currently 80% complete.
- Three new parks are being added Sharon Village and will include parks with outdoor fitness equipment, a splash pad, BMX zone and more. Each park will be interconnected as part of the Sharon Village Trail system.
- Queens Landing Park is 70% complete and focuses on a Canadian design with play area, picnic shelter and a half-court basketball space.

### Capital Projects

- Holland Landing Community Centre Skate Park will begin construction in Spring 2018.
- Lighting will be added to Anchor Park to expand use of the park and improve security. It is anticipated that this project will be complete by Summer 2018.
- The Nokiidaa Trail Extension is now complete from Holland Landing Blvd. to Mount Albert Rd. and Yonge St.
- Queensville Park Playground is being updated to a fire prevention themed park with educational pieces to teach children how to plan escape routes in their homes. The current play equipment will be moved to Mount Albert Lions Park. These works are expected to be complete in December 2017.
- Brenner Park playground will be upgraded in Spring 2018.
