

## CWC/COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

From December 19, 2017

**First tender for 2018 passed** - This tender, which was funded entirely by development charges, came in under budget by \$14,000 thanks to the earliest ever adoption of the Town's budget. It was awarded for the purchase of a dump truck which will be the first anti-ice vehicle in the Town's fleet and will salt and plow roads. During non-winter seasons, the truck will convert to a dump truck to help service the Town's growing inventory of roads.

**19267 Centre St. Update** - Averton has worked with the LSRCA to develop a Compensation Plan, should the proposal be approved by the OMB. The Town continues to work with Averton and the LSRCA to ensure that the locations and work are satisfactory. This proposal is subject to an OMB Hearing scheduled to begin on Jan. 15, 2018.

**Draft Plan of Subdivision & Zoning By-law Amendment Applications** - Rice Commercial Group has filed applications to develop land at 19572 Centre St. in Mount Albert. As part of the initial stages of the applications, Council has scheduled a public meeting to provide an opportunity for comments and resident feedback on the proposal. The public meeting will be held at 7 p.m. in Council Chambers on March 20, 2018. **Civic Precinct Plan Study Update** - Staff have been working with residents and key stakeholders to determine the future vision for the lands surrounding the Civic Centre and Sharon Temple. Ideas that have been identified for consideration include enhanced open spaces for programming, connections to parks and trails, creation of a civic square, and the introduction of a living arts centre, local retail shops and cafes. A public open house will be held on Jan. 23, 2018 for residents to review potential options and provide feedback. **Operations Centre Public Meeting** - A Public Meeting was held for a Zoning By-law Amendment application for the property located at 19850 Woodbine Ave. The proposal would permit a main operations centre building and accessory structures to support Town operations, including roads, water, wastewater, parks, facilities, fleet and Emergency Services.

**York Region Update** - The Town has requested that representatives from York Region attend a Council meeting in early 2018 to update Council on the Upper York Sewage System and other Regional matters.

**East West Road Connections** - Council passed a resolution to be forwarded to York Region, Simcoe County and the Province of Ontario requesting that they actively look to develop east west road connections including the Highway 404 and 400 Connecting Link. The resolution also requested that the Region add the widening of Doane Rd. and the Highway 404 Doane Rd. interchange back into the Region's 10 year capital plan.


