### DOG BY-LAW REMINDERS

2018 dog licences are now available in Customer Service at the Civic Centre or contact Animal Control directly at 1-888-644-5634 to arrange a time to purchase a tag directly from them. Licences are \$31 per dog or \$26 per dog for seniors 65 years and older.

The By-law Branch has received several complaints of dogs off leash. Owners are reminded that under By-law 2004-119, dogs are not allowed to run at large. This helps to ensure safety for other people and the dog. If a dog is found to be off leash the owner could face a fine of \$250 plus a victim surcharge.
