### MOSQUITO CONTROL PROGRAM

#### Notice of aerial application of larvicide to control larval mosquitoes

A vast percentage of land in East Gwillimbury is low-lying terrain, creating perfect breeding sites for the Spring Aedes mosquitoes. Breeding habitats could be found in standing water areas such as woodlands, field pools and ditches that form as the snow melts and spring rains occur.

Beginning on April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2018, weather permitting, the biological larvicide VectoBac 200G [PCP#18158, granular formulation] will be applied by helicopter to standing water mosquito breeding habitats within the Town. This product contains the active ingredient B.t.i. which is very specific to mosquito larvae. Mortality results within 24 hours and biodegrades within 72 hours.

A map showing the treatment areas is available for viewing at the Civic Centre, 19000 Leslie Street, Sharon and at [www.eastgwillimbury.ca/mosquito](http://www.eastgwillimbury.ca/mosquito). Property owners within the treatment areas were mailed objection forms. If you object to having Vectobac applied to your property, please submit a completed Objection Form by Friday, April 6, 2018. No response is required if you support the mosquito control program.
