The first payment was due on February 28th
The second payment is due April 30th

Payments can be made at the Civic Centre, at your bank, online/phone banking OR: Pre-Authorized Payment Plans:

- 10 month installments (Feb to Nov)
- due date installments

If your tax account is not current, a pre-set monthly payment can be arranged to help you catch up on tax arrears. Unpaid taxes will be charged 1.25% per month effective the first day of default.
