Notice of Passing - Council Approves New Comprehensive Zoning By-Law



At the May 15, 2018 Council meeting, Council approved By-Law 2018-043 to update the Town's Zoning By-law. The Town's Zoning By-law has been reviewed, consolidated and updated to reflect current practices. As part of the Comprehensive Zoning By-law Review process undertaken over the past 2+ years, a number of public consultation sessions were held, including three public open houses, two Council workshops and several public meetings. The new Zoning By-law regulates land use and development throughout the Town and affects all lands within the Town, except for four properties that were deferred by Council.

This new Comprehensive Zoning By-law replaces the previous by-law put in place in 1997. Landowners who were previously zoned Rural (RU) will maintain all permitted uses previously allowed in the 1997 by-law. This approval is subject to a 20 day appeal period, after which the new Zoning By-law will come into effect and replace the Town's existing by-law. Appeals must be filed by June 12, 2018.
