

## CWC/COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

From August 14, 2018

**Stormwater Management** - The Town is undergoing a review of its stormwater management facilities to identify short and long term infrastructure repairs. 75% of this project was funded through the Clean Water Wastewater Fund. In addition, the Town is working with York Region, the Town of Newmarket, and Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority (LSRCA) on a pond redesign and retrofit at Leslie Street and Green Lane to reduce phosphorus being released into the LSRCA watershed.

**Council Remuneration** - CWC directed staff to report back a proposed remuneration for the Mayor and Council members for the 2018 to 2022 Council term based on the average remuneration of municipal comparators groups.

**Property Standards and Maintenance By-law** - Council approved the Town's new Property Standards By-law and Property Maintenance By-law. The Town underwent a public engagement process to review the proposed by-laws and have incorporated public comments in the updated by-laws. **Leslie Street Construction Work** - Please be advised that municipal sanitary servicing will be installed along Judah Doan Way and Leslie St. to permit the expansion of Vince's Market. A noise exemption has been passed to allow this 12 week project to occur in the evening, to avoid disruptions during peak traffic periods.

**Mount Albert Streetscape Improvement Project** - The Town has now completed streetscape improvements to the corners of Centre St. and Main St., and the municipal parking facility on Main St. in Mount Albert. The work was coordinated with facility improvements at the DUCA Credit Union site and funded by the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs Main Street Revitalization Initiative.



**Mount Albert Community Message Board** - CWC recommended moving forward with a pilot project for a community message board, to be located in Manor Forest Park. Content for the board will be updated by the Mount Albert Community Recreation Centre Committee.

**Sustainable Homes** - A new home built in East Gwillimbury is the first in Canada to be built as a total water conservation home with over 23% in energy savings. If you are interested in learning more you can attend an open house at 11 a.m. on August 30 at 7 Forest Edge Crescent.

### BEAR SIGHTINGS IN TOWN

The Town has received reports of wild animals, such as bears, within the Town. Wild animals often find their way into residential areas and may tear open garbage, cause concern for residents and come into conflict with pets. Avoid conflict by following these important tips:

- Keep your distance when you encounter a wild animal
- Do not feed animals. This will make them less fearful of humans
- Never attempt to tame a wild animal
- Do not let pets chase animals.
