WINTER PARKING REMINDERS

PROPERTY TAXES DUE

2019 property tax bills were mailed by January 21st, 2019. Payments are due February 28 and April 30. Payments can be made at the Civic Centre, at your bank, online/ phone banking or through a preauthorized payment plan.

If your tax account is not current, a pre-set monthly payment can be arranged to help you catch up on tax arrears. Unpaid taxes will be charged 1.25% interest per month effective the first day of default. Failure to receive a tax bill does not exempt the bill from being due or from incurring interest. 2019 DOG LICENCES

2019 dogs licences are now available in Customer Service at the Civic Centre. Licences are \$35 per dog or \$26 per dog for seniors 65 and older. Licences must be purchased by February 28.



ONTARION ENERGY BOARD NOTICE

Enbridge Gas Inc. has applied to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) to raise its natural gas rates effective January 1, 2019. If the application is approved as filed, the yearly bill of a typical residential customer within the former Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. and Union Gas Limited rate zones will increase.

The OEB will hold a public hearing to consider the application filed by Enbridge Gas Inc. and are looking for feedback from customers. Following the hearing, the OEB will decide whether the rate increase requested in the application will be approved.
