CWC/COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

From March 5, 2019

19267 Centre St., Mount Albert Update - Committee of the Whole Council (CWC) recommended the approval of a Site Plan application for the lands at 19267 Centre St. for a mixed-use building containing 10 residential units, 62 townhouse dwelling units and 2 semi-detached dwelling units. The report will be considered for approval by Council at its meeting on March 19, 2019. For more information and a complete history about this application visit www.eastgwillimbury.ca/projects.

Health & Active Living Plaza Update - The Plaza which is planned for when the Town reaches approximately 40,000 residents, will be proceeding with public consultation and design this year including an aquatics centre, gym with running track and library.
