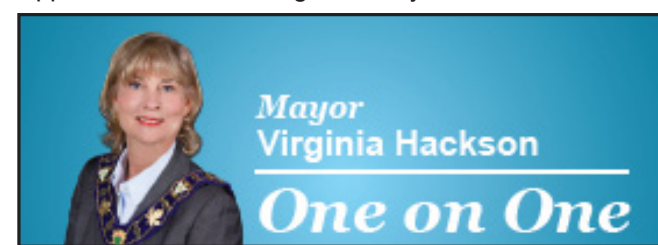
RECREATION FUNDING PROGRAMS

2019 DEVELOPMENT CHARGES

On Tuesday April 16, 2019, Council will hold a public meeting pursuant to the Development Charges Act, 1997 to receive input on the proposed Town-wide development charge by-law and background study.

What are Development Charges?

Development charges are fees that are levied on new development in East Gwillimbury to fund new growth-related capital expenditures.

How can you participate?

All interested parties are invited to attend and may provide feedback relating to the proposed study and by-law. Those wishing to address Town Council must advise the Clerk in writing no later than noon on Friday, April 12, 2019 by e-mail at clerks@eastgwillimbury.ca. All submissions received in writing and those opinions expressed at the public meeting will be considered prior to the enactment of the new development charges by-law.

Next steps

It is proposed that the enactment of a new by-law by Council will occur on a subsequent date to the public meeting.
