LSRCA 2019 Priorities - The Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority (LSRCA) is the local watershed management organization. Their role is to conserve and restore the Lake Simcoe watershed. PROPERTY TAXES

2019 property tax bills were mailed by January 21. The first payment was due on February 28 and the second payment is due on April 30. Payments can be made at the Civic Centre, at your bank, online/phone banking or through a perauthorized payment plan.

If your tax account is not current, a pre-set monthly payment can be arranged to help you catch up on tax arrears. Unpaid taxes will be charged 1.25% interest per month effective the first day of default. Failure to receive a tax bill does not exempt the bill from being due or from incurring interest.
