

## CWC/COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

From May 7, 2019

### York Region Updates

**1. Upper York Sewage System (UYSS)** - The UYSS is the Water Reclamation Centre which is proposed to be located in Queensville. The facility will treat wastewater and help to accommodate growth in York Region. The presentation looked at the history, status and science behind the project. Currently, the project is being reviewed at the Provincial level as part of their duty to consult with the public. The Town will continue to grow to approximately 50,000 residents based on current growth allocation and in order to grow beyond that the Town would need the UYSS or an alternative to provide wastewater allocation. Regional staff will provide additional updates in fall 2019 regarding potential options to take Holland Landing Lagoons offline.

**2. Transportation Services** - The review included an overview of capital projects, including work on Woodbine Ave. and the expansion of the transit facility on Yonge Street. Regional staff also looked at transit services in EG including changes with off peak times which will be converting to on-demand service. ### Road Construction and Capital Engineering Updates

- Council approved the tender award for miscellaneous sidewalk and curb replacements across the Town, with the potential of multi-year work resulting in a 20% cost saving on this project. Council also approved the tender award for asphalt resurfacing of various roads. **Grant Funding Application** - As part of the Town's strategic priority to fiscal responsibility, staff continuously look for grant funding opportunities. Currently, staff are working on an application for funding to implement road, lighting, sidewalk and bridge improvements to Centre Street between King St. and Mt. Albert Rd. as well as the potential for completing connecting links to revitalize downtowns' in Holland Landing and Sharon. Further updates will follow.

**Oriole Road Temporary Closure** - Metrolinx has scheduled repair works at the CN Railway crossing on Oriole Dr. The work will require a temporary road closure of Oriole Dr. between Toll Rd. and Holland Landing Rd. from 8 p.m. on May 31 to 4 a.m. on June 3.

**Mount Albert Fill Site** - A Public Information Centre will be held in late May/early June related to a potential fill site on McCowan Rd, north of Herald Rd.
