Zoning By-Law Update - Following an update memo regarding appeals to the Town's Zoning By-Law, staff were directed to prepare a comprehensive report outlining the process and proposed resolution of the LPAT appeals. Staff were also directed to invite the Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority and interested parties to an evening community open house and educational workshop on September 11. SUMMER WATER RESTRICTIONS

Homes in York Region with odd numbers can use municipal water outdoors on odd numbered days. Homes with even numbers can use water outdoors on even numbered days.

For example, if your house number is 24, you can water on even days of the month (2, 4, 6, etc.).

Follow these tips to keep your lawn and garden healthy while saving water at the same time:

1. If it hasn't rained, water your yard once a week only if needed.
2. Add a layer of mulch to your garden. It keeps the soil moist and the weeds out.
3. Use rainwater to help keep plants hydrated when the weather is hot and dry.
4. Direct sprinklers away from your driveway or sidewalk.
5. Install a rain sensor on your automated sprinkler system to be sure your system is off when it rains.
