### PROPERTY TAXES

Final 2019 residential tax bills have been mailed and payment is due on October 31. Payments can be made at the Civic Centre, at your bank, online/phone banking or through a pre-authorized payment plan.

If your tax account is not current, interest will be charged at 1.25% per month effective the first day of default. To assist with paying off outstanding amounts, a pre-set monthly payment can be arranged with staff in the Tax Department. ## WHAT'S NEW IN EAST GWILLIMBURY

### PEDESTRIAN CROSSOVER



Pedestrians, motorists, and cyclists may have noticed that Centre Street at the Mill Street intersection looks a little different. We're excited to announce that EG's first pedestrian crossover is now live in Mount Albert!

Following a review of the Centre Street corridor a pedestrian crossover was installed to assist residents visiting the medical building and pharmacy on the east side of Centre Street. Pedestrian crossovers are designated areas where pedestrians can safely cross the road, follow these tips to cross pedestrian crossovers safely:

- Use caution.
- Make sure the driver or cyclist has enough time to stop before you begin to cross.
- Make it clear that you want to cross.
- Make sure the driver or cyclist sees you before you begin to cross.
- Cross when traffic has come to a complete stop and you feel it's safe.
