BABYSITTER'S TRAINING — 11-14 years

This certificate program, through the Canadian Safety Council, provides the opportunity for youth to acquire knowledge and skills required to be a responsible babysitter of children from 0-10 years. It will highlight basic first aid, discipline, games, safety, entertaining children and much more. Each participant will receive a student reference book and, upon completion, a certificate. Please send each participant with a doll or stuffed toy to use throughout the day.

HOME ALONE — 9-12 years

This Home Alone program prepares children aged 9-12 years to be on their own at home or elsewhere for short periods of time. Course content includes online safety and internet luring, fire safety, street smarts, stranger and not-so-stranger danger, first aid, and step-by-step home alone readiness plans.
