

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF EAST GWILLIMBURY

BY-LAW NO. 2001-7

A by-law of the Corporation of the Town of East Gwillimbury to regulate, govern or prohibit the operation of motorized snow vehicle within the municipality including on highways therein or any part or parts thereof

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 7(2) of the Motorized Snow Vehicles Act R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.44 that the Council of the local municipality may pass by-laws as follows.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Corporation of the Town of East Gwillimbury enacts as follows:

1. Definitions

For the purpose of this by-law:

- 1.1 "Highway" includes common and public highway, street, avenue, parkway, driveway, square, place, bridge, viaduct, or trestle, and any part of which is intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles and includes the area between the lateral property lines thereof;
- 1.2 "Person(s)" shall mean any human being, association, firm, partnership, private club, incorporated company, corporation, agent or trustee and the heirs, executors or other legal representatives of a person to whom the context can apply according to law and for the purpose of this by-law includes the owner or driver of a motorized snow vehicle;
- 1.3 "Motorized Snow Vehicle" means a self propelled vehicle designed to be driven primarily on snow;
- 1.4 "Municipal Property" means land owned, managed, or controlled by the Town or made available to the Town by lease agreement, or otherwise, and includes Town parks, walkways, municipal parking lots, but does not include a highway.
- 1.5 "Sidewalk" means that part of a public street for the use of pedestrians, being exclusively reserved for them and constructed somewhat differently than other portions of the street;
- 1.6 "Town" means the Corporation of the Town of East Gwillimbury.

2. No person shall drive, cause or permit a motorized snow vehicle to be driven on a sidewalk within the territorial limits of the Town of East Gwillimbury except for the purpose of directly crossing the sidewalk.
3. No person shall drive a motorized snow vehicle on Municipal property at any time. The exception being where there is a written agreement in place with the Town and an insurance policy in place naming the Town as co-insured for 5 million dollars worth of liability coverage per occurrence.

4. Penalties

- 4.1 Every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence.

4.2 Every person who is convicted of an offence is liable to a fine not exceeding \$1,000.00 as provided for in the Motorized Snow Vehicle Act R.S.O., 1990, Chapter M.44.

4 This by-law shall take effect and come into force on the date that it is finally passed by Council.
