NOTICE OF PUBLIC DESIGN OPEN HOUSE

FOR GRIST MILL PARK, PARKWAY PARK & HOLLAND LANDING COMMUNITY CENTRE PARK AND SPLASH PAD

PARK UPGRADES AND RENOVATIONS:

The Town of East Gwillimbury completed a town-wide study to develop a Community Parks, Recreation & Culture Master Plan Study in fall of 2008 with the goal to articulate the planning and developmental needs and priorities associated with recreation programs, facilities, culture, parks, trails and open space. The result of these analyses are over eighty strategic actions guiding the Town to effectively deliver parks, recreation and cultural facilities and services to the current and future residents of East Gwillimbury.

One of the actions identified in the plan was the upgrade and renovation of existing park facilities and in particular facilities within the Holland Landing area, specifically Holland Landing Community Centre Park, Parkway Park (formerly River Drive Park) and Grist Mill Park. These parks sites are all recognized for their value as local amenity spaces and as a result have been scheduled for renovation during the 2010 construction season. Renovations will include the replacement of existing playground equipment and improvements to other features of the parks, including the addition of a water or splash feature at Parkway Park and the Holland Landing Community Centre.

PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE:

You are invited to a public open house and information session to meet the design team and Town staff to review the Council approved landscape design concepts for Grist Mill Park, Parkway Park and Holland Landing Community Centre Park and Splash Pad.

The design team will be present to answer questions and discuss the concept plans. The meeting will be an "Open House" format so residents may drop-in over the course of the event as there will not be a formal presentation at a specific time.

SUPPLY & DELIVERY OF WATER METERS

Supply and delivery of a maximum of 600 Sensus SR11 5/8 x 3/4 water meters with ECR waterproof remote registers. The price quoted shall be honoured for two years from the date of contract award. All meters are to be delivered to the Town of East Gwillimbury's Waterworks Trailer located at 1914A Mount Albert Road, Sharon, ON, LOG 1V0.

REQUIREMENTS BEFORE ISSUANCE OF CONTRACT:

The Supplier will confirm the ability to deliver the products on an as needed basis with a maximum lead time of 1 week. The Town will notify the Supplier when meters are needed and the Supplier shall deliver to the address noted above.

QUANTITIES:

This quotation requires the supply of a maximum of 600 Sensus SR11 5/8 x 3/4 water meters with ECR waterproof remote registers. The unit price for each water meter shall include all applicable costs (including HST).
