PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRES

Class Environmental Assessment Study for a New Operations Centre

The Town of East Gwillimbury has initiated a Class Environmental Assessment study (Class EA) for a proposed operations centre. This study is being conducted as a Schedule 'C' project in accordance with the Class EA process, which is an approved process under the Environmental Assessment Act.

It is anticipated that the existing operations centre will not adequately meet the future needs of the Town to meet population growth projections. A facility is required by the Town to accommodate projected growth and ensure that the Town's infrastructure and current levels of service can be maintained or enhanced as the Town moves forward.

An important part of the Class EA process is consultation with agency and public stakeholders. The first Public Information Centre (PIC) for this project was held in November 2009 to provide a description of the problems/opportunities, the need and justification for a new operations centre, documentation of existing environmental conditions within the study area and an assessment of alternative solutions.

The purpose of PIC #2 is to review the Class EA process completed to date, review the site screening and evaluation criteria, present the evaluation of the alternative sites and identify the recommended site(s).

GRIST MILL RECONSTRUCTION

A PUBLIC INFORMATION SESSION in an "Open House Format" will be held on **Monday, April 12, 2010**, to discuss the engineering plans and construction of the proposed Grist Mill Road Reconstruction from Mount Albert Road to Hill Top Drive.

The purpose of the reconstruction is to improve the long term reliability of the water delivery system by replacing the existing aged pipe. The road itself will also be upgraded to a standard modern urbanized setting.

The format will be "Open House" and you are invited to drop in any time between 4:30 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. Subject to a successful tender and contract award, the project is planned to commence in summer 2010.

Project drawings will be on display and representatives from the Town of East Gwillimbury will be available to answer questions, receive comments and provide any additional information.
