THINKING GREEN



Conserve water this season by installing a rain barrel; stormwater runoff is collected in rain barrels and can be used for many household tasks that usually consume large amounts of treated tap water. For example, rain barrel water is ideal for watering gardens, indoor plants, washing your car or the windows of your home. Harvesting water can help reduce the volume of stormwater reaching sewer treatment facilities, provides a source of water during drought like conditions, and ultimately reduces the demand for tap water which can save money on your water bill. If you are interested in purchasing a rain barrel, York Region's Water for Tomorrow program is having a Rain Barrel Sale on Saturday, May 29th from 7:30am to 1:00pm at the East Gwillimbury GO Station.
