NOTICE TO RESIDENTS - WINTER TIPS

To promote winter safety and provide effective snow clearing and removal of ice and snow from Town streets we would like to remind residents of the following:

- Do not push snow from your driveway onto the street or across the street onto other properties
- Do not place or deposit snow or ice in a ditch or in a manner to obstruct a culvert or other drainage outlets
- Depositing snow or ice on the street may create hazardous street conditions which could possibly result in a traffic accident
- If you live on a corner property and the driveway is close to the corner, there is a good chance that snow build up on your driveway will be more than your neighbours due to turning of the snow plow. This is unavoidable
- Remember keeping parked cars off the street will speed up snow removal and increase community safety
- Do not block a fire hydrant with snow
