FIREARM DISCHARGE/DEER HUNT

During the week of November 29th to December 3rd, 2010 the Ministry of Natural Resources will hold a controlled deer hunt.

Town of East Gwillimbury By-law #2004-81 regulates the discharge of firearms (not hunting) within the Town. The By-law and Discharge Area map are available for review at www.eastgwillimbury.ca, under By-Law & Licensing Services.
