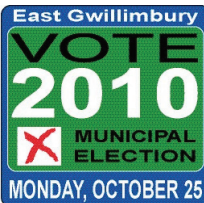

## PROXY VOTING

### WHAT IS A PROXY VOTE?

A Proxy Vote allows any person entitled to vote to appoint another qualified elector to vote for them.

### HOW DO I ARRANGE FOR PROXY VOTING?

You can call the Town Offices at (905) 478-4282 Ext 1253 or Ext 1232 to receive a proxy voting form by mail or you may pick one up at the Clerk's Office during regular business hours. After you have completed your portion of the form, the elector you appoint (who must also be entitled to vote in the Town of East Gwillimbury) must present both copies of the form **in person** to the Clerk's Office, Town of East Gwillimbury Civic Centre, 19000 Leslie Street, Sharon, Ontario, for certification.

The person appointing the other elector to vote for them and the person appointed must both be on the Voters List before the proxy can be certified. The appointment may only be made from September 13<sup>th</sup> up to and including October 25, 2010 (voting day), and must be made in the prescribed form. The form may be certified during normal office hours Monday to Friday, 8:30a.m. to 4:30 p.m. or on the day of an Advance Vote.
