



## SNOWMOBILE SAFETY



Keeping An Eye on  
East Gwillimbury

The East Gwillimbury Community Safety Committee is offering the following snowmobile safety tips:

- Ice is never safe – stay on the trail and stay safe
- Keep your license, insurance, ownership, trail pass and trail pass receipt with you at all times
- A DOT- or CSA-approved helmet with the chin strap done up is mandatory
- Snowmobiling is not permitted on Town sidewalks
- Obey speed limits – maximum is 50km/h, lower in some areas
- Always cross roads at a right angle to traffic
- Let family & friends know your planned route, destination and expected arrival time.

## WINTER STREETS AND SIDEWALKS

In order to help Town staff keep sidewalks clear during the winter months, please don't park motorized vehicles over a sidewalk or footpath. Also, please keep curbing, flower boxes and other items at least 30cm (1 foot) back from sidewalks. Our snow removal equipment might come into contact with closer items causing damage to the machinery.
