A project is currently underway to protect soil and trees in Sharon West. Siltation fencing is being installed to prevent soil erosion and to preserve trees when development work begins sometime in the future. Although construction in that area is not scheduled yet, developers are making preparations now while ground conditions are favourable. The fencing will stay in place until development is complete, and reports will be discussed at Town Council before construction begins. A Public Information Centre will be held to discuss the proposed Fill and Site Alteration By-law and draft Operational Guideline. "Open House" style with a presentation at 7:00pm.

Monday, January 9, 2012, 4:30-8:30pm, Holland Landing Room, EG Civic Centre, 19000 Leslie St.,

The purpose of the proposed By-law and draft guideline is to prohibit or regulate the placing or dumping of fill and site alteration of land to ensure that existing drainage patterns are maintained and appropriate environmental protections are in place to protect groundwater and prevent the importation of hazardous material.
