## NOTICE TO RESIDENTS – WINTER TIPS

To promote winter safety and provide effective snow clearing and removal of ice and snow from Town streets we would like to remind residents of the following:

- Do not push snow from your driveway onto the street or across the street onto other properties
- Do not place or deposit snow or ice in a ditch or in a manner to obstruct a culvert or other drainage outlets as per the Encumbrancing By-law 96-31
- Depositing snow or ice on the street may create hazardous street conditions which could possibly result in a traffic accident
- If you live on a corner property and the driveway is close to the corner, there is good chance that snow build up on your driveway will be more than your neighbours due to turning operations of the snow plow, this is unavoidable
- Remember keeping parked cars off the street will speed up snow removal and increase community safety as per the Parking By-law 2003-24 (as amended)
- Do not block a fire hydrant with snow

## PROPOSED FILL AND SITE ALTERATION BY-LAW

A Public Information Centre will be held to discuss the proposed Fill and Site Alteration By-law and draft Operational Guideline. "Open House" style with a presentation at 7:00pm.

Monday, January 9, 2012, 4:30-8:30pm, Holland Landing Room, EG Civic Centre, 19000 Leslie St.,

The purpose of the proposed By-law and draft guideline is to prohibit or regulate the placing or dumping of fill and site alteration of land to ensure that existing drainage patterns are maintained and appropriate environmental protections are in place to protect groundwater and prevent the importation of hazardous material.
