



MOSQUITO CONTROL

Notice of pesticide use

As in previous years, the granular biological control agent Vectobac (Bti) [No. 18158 registered under the *Pest Control Products Act (Canada)*] will be applied by helicopter to hardwood bush and areas with an abundance of standing water throughout the Town of East Gwillimbury during early to mid-April during daylight hours, weather permitting.

A map indicating the areas of application is available for viewing during regular business hours in the Town Civic Centre, Corporate Services Department and on the Town's web site eastgwillimbury.ca. You must submit the mosquito submission form to the Town of East Gwillimbury in writing by no later than Friday, March 18th, 2011, indicating whether:

- you approve of having the Vectobac applied to your property; or
- you object to having the Vectobac applied to your property;

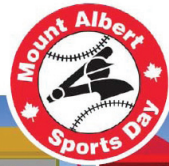

SNOWMOBILE SAFETY



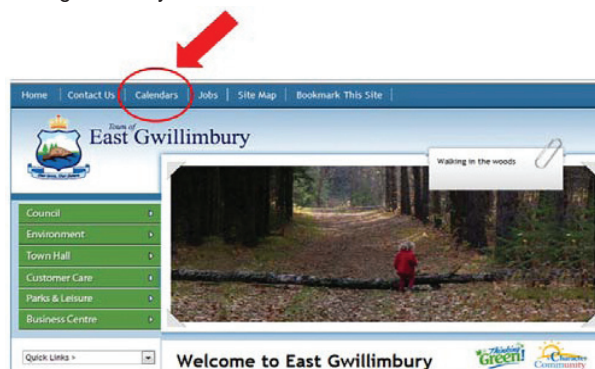
Keeping An Eye on East Gwillimbury

The East Gwillimbury Community Safety Committee is offering the following snowmobile safety tips:

- Ice is never safe – stay on the trail and stay safe
- Keep your license, insurance, ownership, trail pass and trail pass receipt with you at all times
- A DOT- or CSA-approved helmet with the chin strap done up is mandatory
- Snowmobiling is not permitted on Town sidewalks
- Obey speed limits – maximum is 50km/h, lower in some areas
- Always cross roads at a right angle to traffic
- Let family & friends know your planned route, destination and expected arrival time

LOAD RESTRICTIONS

Load Restrictions as per Town By-law #82-19, as authorized by the Highway Traffic Act, will be in effect on all Town roads from Tuesday, March 1, 2011 to Saturday, April 30, 2011. Restrictions may be extended if conditions warrant. The restrictions require that no axle of any commercial vehicle shall transmit to the highways a weight in excess of 5,000 kilograms.
