CONTRACT PR-2011-01 - NOKIIDAA TRAIL – GREENLANE EAST TO 2nd CONCESSION TRAIL CONSTRUCTION WORKS

The Corporation of the Town of East Gwillimbury is requesting tenders for the construction enhancement and creation of a section of the Nokiidaa Trail leading from Greenlane East at the Holland River crossing in the south, to 2nd Concession Road at Rogers Reservoir in the north. The construction will include all necessary works associated with the reconstruction of the existing trail to the Town's new 3 metre wide multi-use trail standard.
