PROPERTY TAXES DUE

The final 2011 property tax bills were mailed June 10, 2011 and the 2nd installment is due: October 31, 2011.

We encourage the payment of your tax bill through the pre-authorized tax payment. Two pre-authorized payment plans are available for enrollment throughout the year, however, tax accounts must be current.

Option #1 – 10 Month Installment Plan
(February – November)

Withdrawal date is the 15th of each month.

Option #2 – Due Date Installment Plan

Payment can also be made by telephone/internet banking, at any Chartered Bank or in person by cash, cheque or direct debit at the Civic Centre.

All unpaid taxes will be charged an interest charge of 1.25% per month effective the 1st day of default. Please contact the Finance Department at 905-478-4283 ext. 1229 if you did not receive a tax bill.

She is the author of seven internationally acclaimed novels entitled, *The Whirlpool*, *Changing Heaven*, *Away*, *The Underpainter*, *The Stone Carvers*, *A Map of Glass*, and *Sanctuary Line*.

The Whirlpool received the French Prix du Meilleur Livre Étranger (Best Foreign Book Award). *Away*, was winner of the Trillium Award and a finalist for the prestigious International IMPAC Dublin Literary Award. *The Underpainter*, won the Governor General's Award. *The Stone Carvers*, was a finalist for The Giller Prize and the Governor General's Award, and longlisted for the Booker Prize. *A Map of Glass*, was a finalist for a regional Commonwealth Writers' Prize for Best Book. *Sanctuary Line* her latest book was published in 2010.
