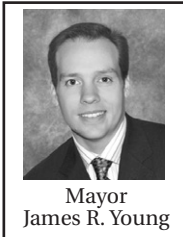

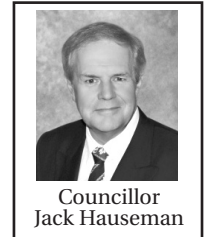

You are invited to attend a Public Open House regarding the Town's Consolidated Official Plan Review and Update. The Town's Official Plan guides growth and development while protecting the natural and rural environments. The Planning Act requires municipalities to review their Official Plan at least once every five years.

The Official Plan Review will emphasize the creation of a sustainable and complete community stressing the environment, society & culture, infrastructure and the economy.

The Official Plan Review and Update will focus on the following matters:

- Protection and Enhancement of the Town's Countryside (Natural Heritage and Agriculture);
- Designation of additional employment lands to ensure balanced growth;
- Provision of a comprehensive strategy for the delivery of services and infrastructure on a Town-wide basis;
- Standardization of Town-wide policies for development including:
  - Phasing of non-residential (employment uses) with residential;
  - Development Phasing relative to Infrastructure;
  - Consistent Urban Design and Architectural Control;
- Consolidation of the policies within the Town's various secondary plans;
- Conformity exercise associated with the Provincial "Places to Grow" Growth Plan and Greenbelt Plan;
- Preparing policies to guide intensification and sustainable growth.



The Town's Official Plan Review is supported by background studies that include: Water and Sanitary Servicing Master Plans, Transportation Master Plan, Natural Heritage/Environmental Features System update, Community Facilities Master Plan, Fiscal Impact Analysis and Development Charges Background Study, and an Economic Corridor Land Use Study in conjunction with the Region of York.

### WATERMAIN CLEANING

#### WATERMAIN CLEANING PROGRAM IN MOUNT ALBERT

Residents are reminded that the Town will undertake a cleaning (foam swabbing) program for a portion of the water system in Mount Albert between the end of June and the beginning of July.

Individual notification letters will be hand-delivered to residents, at least 48 hours prior to the work commencing on your street. The letter will provide the exact date of when the cleaning will take place on each street and explain the related water disruption.

It is recommended that residents do not use water during the specified period as you may experience partial or complete loss of pressure during the cleaning process.

### PARKING NOTICE

#### SURVEY RESULTS – ON STREET PARKING PASS PROGRAM

In March of 2007 the Town conducted a survey of certain streets in Holland Landing and Mount Albert that were identified by a technical audit study to be able to accommodate on-street parking in excess of three hours. The survey was mailed out to affected residents to obtain their opinion of an On-Street Parking Pass Program.

The responses were analyzed and the results were reported to Council. The results showed that neither an On-Street Parking Pass Program nor longer term/overnight parking is required in the Town and subsequently Council decided that no change be made to the existing Parking By-law, which provides for on-street parking to a maximum of three (3) hours, provided it does not interfere with snow removal.
