WATERMAIN CLEANING

WATERMAIN CLEANING PROGRAM IN MOUNT ALBERT

Residents are reminded that the Town will undertake a cleaning (foam swabbing) program for a portion of the water system in Mount Albert between the end of June and the beginning of July.

Individual notification letters will be hand-delivered to residents, at least 48 hours prior to the work commencing on your street. The letter will provide the exact date of when the cleaning will take place on each street and explain the related water disruption.

It is recommended that residents do not use water during the specified period as you could experience partial or complete loss of pressure during the cleaning process.
