



FINES AND FEES

Effective June 1, 2010, the EGPL Board has approved changes to the Library's Circulation Policy. These changes are to ensure that materials are returned in a timely manner so that all patrons can enjoy them. Collecting fines for overdue items helps the Library to offset costs in other areas, and helps to keep as many services as possible for free or at a low cost.
