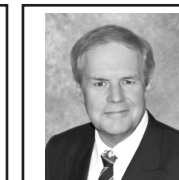

Lowering the thermostat 2 to 3 degrees at night and when leaving the house can save you a significant amount of energy use. A simple 1 degree reduction on the thermostat will save on average 2% on home energy costs.

**FIREARM DISCHARGE/DEER HUNT**

During the weeks of November 5th to the 9th and December 3rd to the 7th, 2007, the Ministry of Natural Resources will hold a controlled deer hunt.
