York Region United Way Campaign Kicks Off

Town Awards Contract for Community Parks, Recreation and Culture Master Plan

Monteith Brown Planning Consultants have been awarded the contract to produce a Community Parks, Recreation and Culture Strategic Master Plan and Parks Design Standards Manual. The report will be completed by June 2, 2008 and aligns with the Town's Strategic Plan by protecting natural heritage systems and planning and delivering core services to cultivate a viable community.

Customer Care Improvements Continue

Council adopted a report to commence on customer care renovations at the Civic Centre. The first phase of the renovation will affect the Finance Department and make it easier and more efficient for residents to pay for services and user fees.

At the Committee of the Whole Council meeting on Monday, October 15, 2007 Council approved the timelines for the adoption of the 2008 Business Plans and Budgets.
