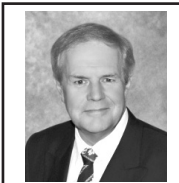

## COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

### East Gwillimbury Says "No" To Waste Facility

East Gwillimbury Council unanimously passed a motion declaring that it will not be a willing host for the proposed Durham and York Region's joint residual waste processing and energy from waste facility. East Gwillimbury Council is supportive of waste diversion options that encourage the sustainability of the environment. However, there are several key issues that have not been addressed with the proposed East Gwillimbury site. These concerns include potential impacts to Natural Heritage, Air Emissions, Agriculture, and Traffic on Local Roads. Copies of the resolution are available.

### East Gwillimbury's First Thinking Green! Subdivision Moving to Model Homes Stage

The Harvest Hills subdivision site has been approved to commence with Model Home construction. Among being East Gwillimbury's first complete Energy Star @ community, Harvest Hills will also incorporate other Thinking Green! policies such as trails, roundabout traffic calming and many other features.

### Green Bin Collection Communications Program Approved
