PROPERTY TAXES DUE

The final 2009 property tax bills were mailed on June 26, 2009.

Payment is due as follows:

1st installment due: August 31, 2009
2nd installment due: October 30, 2009

We encourage the payment of your tax bill through the pre-authorized tax payment plan or telephone/internet banking. Payment can also be made at any Chartered Bank or in person by cash, cheque or direct debit at the Civic Centre.

There are two pre-authorized payment plans available:

Option #1 – Monthly Installment Plan. Withdrawal date is the 15th of each month.

Option #2 – Due Date Installment Plan

Please contact the Finance Department at 905-478-4282 ext. 1229 if you did not receive a tax bill or wish further information about the pre-authorized tax payment plan.

All unpaid taxes will be charged an interest charge of 1.25% per month.
