2008 MOSQUITO CONTROL PROGRAM NOTICE OF PESTICIDE USE:

As in previous years, the granular biological control agent Vectobac (Bti) [No. 18158 registered under the Pest Control Products Act (Canada)] will be applied aerially (by helicopter) to hardwood bush and areas with an abundance of standing water throughout the Town of East Gwillimbury during early to mid-April during daylight hours, weather permitting.

A map indicating the areas of application is available for viewing during regular business hours in the Town Civic Centre, Corporate Services Department (address as indicated below) and on the Town's web site.

If your property is located within the treatment area and you do not wish to have your property treated, please advise the Town of East Gwillimbury in writing or by e-mail by no later than **Wednesday, March 26th, 2008.**
