NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

In the matter of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, and in the matter of the lands and premises at the following municipal address in the Town of East Gwillimbury, in the Regional Municipality of York, in the Province of Ontario.

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of East Gwillimbury intends to designate the property known as 574 Green Lane East, Part of Lot 101, Concession 1, EYS, including lands and buildings, as a property of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990.

Built in 1864, the house located on this property is an intact example of a mid-nineteenth century farmhouse for this area. Its proportions and architectural style reflect the typical Ontario centre-gabled 1 1/2 storey dwelling, constructed of double thickness red and yellow brick. It features an attached board-and-batten woodshed with a small belfry. Further information concerning the proposed designation is available through the Community Planning and Development Branch of the Town's Development and Legal Services Department.

Any person may, before the **5th day of June, 2008**, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Town of East Gwillimbury notice of his/her objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and relevant facts. When a Notice of Objection has been received, the Council of the Town of East Gwillimbury will refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing and report.

Emergency Survival Checklist (Three-day supply per person)

- Flashlight and batteries
- Clothing and footwear
- Radio and batteries or crank radio
- Blankets or sleeping bags
- Spare batteries for radio or flashlight
- Toilet paper and other personal items
- First-aid Kit
- Medication
- Candles and matches/lighter
- Backpack/duffel bag (to hold all of the emergency survival kit items)
- Extra car keys and cash
- Important papers (identification)
- Whistle (to attract attention, if needed)
- Food and bottled water
- Playing cards, games

BUILDING PERMIT FEES REVISION
