EG - LET'S BE IDLE FREE

The Town of East Gwillimbury is dedicated to protecting the environment and as part of the "Thinking Green!" initiative, anti-idling is an important issue.

Idling our vehicles produces unnecessary pollution that contributes to greenhouse gas emissions, smog, and health problems. It wastes fuel and is not helpful in the longevity of your vehicle's engine.

Did you know that...

1. Vehicle idling in the Greater Toronto Area accounts for 214,020 tons of greenhouse gasses per year, enough to fill approximately 200,000 suburban homes.
2. It has been estimated that three percent of Ontario's fuel is wasted by idling.
3. Children breathe twice as much air as adults, making them more susceptible to airborne pollutants such as those released by idling.
4. Ten seconds of idling uses more fuel than stopping and restarting the engine.
