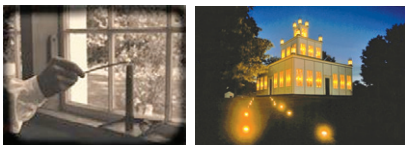

MOUNT ALBERT ROAD CLOSURE

Ministry of Transportation
Temporary Mount Albert Road Closure

The Ontario Ministry of Transportation has advised that they will be commencing construction of the overpass structure at Mt. Albert Road.

Mount Albert Road will be closed from Colonel Weyling Boulevard to Woodbines Avenue from September 2, 2008 until December 31, 2008.

The Ministry of Transportation has designated the detour route as Queensville Sideroad and Green Lane via Woodbine Avenue or Leslie Street. Project officials will be delivering notices door-to-door to directly impacted area residents.

Water conservation is an easy way to save money, energy and help the environment. An example of water conservation is turning off the tap while brushing your teeth. If you leave the tap running it wastes up to 17 litres of water a minute. When shaving, try to fill the bottom of the sink with a few inches of water to rinse your razor rather than leaving the water running. Try not to use hot water whenever possible by opting for cold water laundry, shortening showers and turning your water heater off when away from your home for an extended period of time.
