
Being a By-law to adopt the Official Plan for the Town of East Gwillimbury


WHEREAS the matters set out herein are deemed to be in conformity with the Official Plan for the Regional Municipality of York;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of East Gwillimbury, in accordance with the provisions of Sections 17 and 21 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13 as amended, enacts as follows:

1. The Town of East Gwillimbury Official Plan, consisting of text, figures and maps, attached hereto as Schedule "A", is hereby adopted.
2. That existing Official Plan Amendment # 95 as amended by the Oak Ridges Moraine conformity Amendment, OPA # 116, the Community Plans of Holland Landing-River Drive Park (OPA # 60) as amended, Queensville (OPA # 89, as amended by OPA # 115), Sharon (OPA # 122 as amended), Mount Albert (OPA # 72 as amended by Oak Ridges Moraine conformity Amendment OPA # 117), and Green Lane West (OPA # 110) as amended, are hereby repealed.
3. That the Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to make application to the Regional Municipality of York for approval of the new Official Plan for the Town of East Gwillimbury and to request the Regional Municipality of York to approve the repeal of the above mentioned Official Plan Amendments.
4. That Section 2 of this By-law will not come into force until the date upon which the new Official Plan for the Town of East Gwillimbury, or any part thereof, first receives approval pursuant to Section 17 of the Planning Act.
5. Despite Sections 2, 3 and 4 of this By-law, the existing Official Plan Amendments noted above shall continue in force with respect to any lands within the Town of East Gwillimbury for which approval of the new Official Plan is not granted on that date referred to in Section 4 of this By-law, and shall continue in force with respect to those lands until such time as the new Official Plan receives approval under Section 17 of the *Planning Act*.
