

## WINTER ROAD PATROL (4 Positions) (38 Hour Work Week)

Reporting to the Roads Foreman, the Winter Road Patrol would be responsible for road and sidewalk winter patrolling, computerized data entry, assist with ongoing winter maintenance activities in accordance with Provincial Maintenance Standards. Other duties may include the daily routine maintenance of Town roads, sidewalks and rights-of-way. There will be a requirement to be available outside of the regular scheduled shift to perform winter operations including; sidewalk maintenance, snow clearing and removal as required.

- Minimum Class G driver's license in good standing with Driver's Abstract.
- Experience operating equipment such as; tractor, loader, 1 ton pick-up truck with or without plow considered an asset.
- Knowledge of construction and trained in operation of related small tools and equipment.
- Trained in Book 7 Short Duration Stops and Traffic Control considered an asset.
- Able to work 4 shifts per week (afternoons & nights) and overtime.
- Knowledge of WHMIS and Occupational Health & Safety Act.
- Understanding of Health & Safety issues relevant to daily operations/equipment usage.
- Ability to work with limited supervision.
- Ability to work as part of a team.
- Proficient time management skills and flexibility in adjusting between varieties of duties.
