Council held two days of 2019 Business Plan and Budget deliberations. The deliberations reviewed the operating budget (annual cost for each department), the development and fee supported budget (programs that are paid for by development fees) as well as the capital budget (projects or initiatives that are one-time or time specific). The budget provides for the continuation of current services and programs and dedicated increases are proposed for community safety and the operations of the upcoming Health & Active Living Plaza which will feature gymnasium, library and aquatics facility.

WINTER PARKING REMINDERS

Winter weather is on its way and this week's forecast is calling for ongoing flurries. As a reminder, our snowplows will be deployed to ensure Town roads are cleared and safe. Please remove all vehicles off the road during snow events so our plows can navigate roads safely. Follow these tips to ensure you are prepared for winter parking:

Parking Consideration Forms

Residents can request for temporary roadway parking through the use of the Parking Consideration Form. The consideration provides temporary relief from the three-hour maximum for special circumstances. Considerations are issued for occasional and short-term parking at the discretion of the By-law Branch, but are not valid during a snow event.

Parking Exemption Period

To allow for guest parking, residents may also park on the road between 7 and 11 p.m., in addition to the three-hour parking limit, except during a snow event. This would allow for parking for three hours before, and after the exemption period.

A public meeting will be held for proposed Zoning By-law Amendment (ZBA.18.10), Draft Plan of Subdivision (19T-18003) and Draft Plan of Condominium (CDM.18.01) applications for 464 Mount Albert. These applications propose to rezone and subdivide the subject lands to permit 14 townhouse units, 6 single detached dwellings and an open space area.
